Janice currently lives in an unsafe neighborhood. In addition to plumbing and heating problems, her house lacks accommodations for mobility. About ten years ago, Janice went to a Habitat class because she was interested in becoming a homeowner. Janice did not follow through with the application because she did not believe she would be accepted based off her age and disabilities.

Ten years forward, Janice's friend told her that Habitat was taking applications and encouraged her to follow through the whole process. Janice thought to herself "This is my chance". She filled out the application and got accepted!!

Janice has worked hard on becoming a homeowner. She has taken many classes on how to budget her finances and take care of her home on her own. Janice has worked in our ReStore as well as working hard on the construction site.
